




1. Piki Market Process



1. Piki Market Process

To sell, buy, or transfer artworks using Piki Market, you need to sign up for membership first. If you have completed the registration process, shall we go and create your own special artwork?



2. Sign up

You can use various Piki services including Piki Market by signing up for XTRION integrated membership.

First, enter the email address you want to use and then enter the 6-digit verification code that was sent to you.

Once you have completed the verification, enter your desired password and confirm it once again.

If you agree to the terms of use and the collection and use of personal information, your registration will be completed.


Upon registration, your wallet and gallery will be automatically created.

3-1. What is Gallery?

The Gallery is a space where you can view the artworks and Series you have created or own, as well as transaction history. It is similar to the concept of a profile page.



1) Created Artworks

A tab where you can view the artworks that you have created (edit/register artwork)



2) Owned Artworks

A tab where you can view the works that you own (sell/cancel sale/transfer/share)



3) Series

A tab where you can view the series that you have created



4) Transaction History

A tab where you can view your transaction history



5) Liked Artworks

A tab where you can see the works you have liked



6) Bookmarked Artworks

A tab where you can view the Series you are interested in



3-2. How do I get gallery certification?

The Pink Mark next to the gallery's nickname is given to an account certified by the Piki Market.

Account certification mark can be granted or removed according to verification and loss policies.

This certification mark is an important mark given only to verified accounts except for fake accounts in the Piki Market.

Trust and purchase artworks created by accounts with certification marks.

- 1. Verification policy
- 1) Active accounts that have purchased or sold one or more pieces within the past month
- 2) Account whose email address is verified
- 3) Account for which profile pictures and banners are verified
- 4) Account certified by another existing artwork market
- 5) Accounts at high impersonation risk or requiring fast authentication
- 6) An account of great artistic, technical, social innovation or merit.

An account that has already been certified can lose its certification mark at any time if it acts to disqualify it.


In addition, Piki Market reserves the right to remove the certification mark of the account at any time, for any reason, without prior notice.

- 2. Loss policy
- 1) Accounts that violate the service terms and conditions
- 2) Accounts using copyrighted content
- 3) Where there is a history of being reported, the account where the report is reasonable

3-3. How do I set up the Gallery?

During the registration process, your personal gallery will be automatically created, and a default nickname will be set for you. You can change your nickname, set a profile image, a banner image, and even customize your unique gallery domain.

If you wish to modify your gallery information, you can select the "Edit" option to make the desired changes.




4-1. What is Series and how do I create it?

A Series is a concept of a folder in which several artworks are grouped into the same category.

When you create artwork, you can create a new Series or select an existing Series.

You can find the Series you created in My Gallery > Series.




4-2. How can I add a Series that I'm interested in?

You can use the Bookmark feature to collect the Series that you are interested in.

Go to the page of the Series that you're interested in and add it to your Bookmark List.

The Series that you have bookmarked can be viewed in "My Gallery" > "Bookmarked Series".



5-1. What are the benefits of recording an artwork on the blockchain?

By using XTO602, a blockchain technology, it can serve as a "certificate of authenticity" for the work. Simply put, any form of digital content such as images, videos, audio, GIFs, etc. can be given a unique value and recorded on the blockchain, allowing for a form of "digital certification of authenticity" as something that "exists only once in the world".



Even if the same digital content file is duplicated, each work is distinguished by assigning unique values to each of them as their individual values. At this point, the ownership and transaction history of the work are recorded and stored on the blockchain, allowing the original creator to be identified at any time. It is impossible to forge the work because it cannot be arbitrarily altered by anyone.

5-2. How are artworks distinguished?

Artworks are broadly divided into two types: Digital and Physical.

Digital works refer to works based on digital files.

For example, a unique ID is assigned to an image file, and all information such as the source, distribution process (sales history), owner, etc. of the file is stored.

It becomes a scarce digital asset token that is irreplaceable and has no duplicates.

Physical works refer to works that are based on physical objects.

Since they are based on physical objects, the artwork has a stake in the physical object.

Think of it as "the owner of the work has a stake in the physical object."

Users can receive the physical product and own it.






5-3. How do I explore artwork?


If you know the information of the work you are looking for accurately, try using the search bar.

If you want to explore in more detail, you can use the sorting criteria dropdown menu to select search ranges by popularity, high price, low price, or newest.



6-1. How do I create artwork?

New artwork can be created through the artwork creation menu. All created artworks are recorded on the blockchain.

You can move to the artwork creation screen by clicking on the artwork creation tab in the top menu.

Currently, Piki Market supports two types of artworks - Digital and Physical - and two types of creation forms - Single and Bulk.






Digital

: A digital form of artwork that can be traded digitally by turning it into a digital file.



Physical:

A physical form of artwork that has been turned into an artwork, allowing not only digital artwork but also actual products to be shipped.





Single Creation

: Creating one artwork at a time.



Bulk Creation


: Creating multiple artworks at once.

Select the types of the artwork and creation, upload the original file of the artwork, and enter the title and description of the artwork.

The creation quantity is divided into two types: Single and Fractions.


For a single artwork, you can set the edition quantity, and for a fraction artwork, you can set the number of pieces.

Note that the original file and title of the artwork cannot be modified due to the nature of the blockchain, so please double-check before proceeding with the creation.


6-2. How can I modify information for a created artwork?

Once a artwork is created, it is recorded on the blockchain.

Due to the nature of the blockchain supported by the Piki Market, the original artwork cannot be modified.

But basic information such as the title, description, category, hashtag, Series, and royalty of the artwork can be changed.


It can only be modified before the artwork is registered.



7-1. How can I know the status of purchasing artwork?

The status of the artwork can be divided into three categories: Not for sale / For sale soon / For sale.

1) Not for sale: This refers to the state before the current owner registers the artwork for sale.




In this state, the purchase button is disabled, and buyers cannot purchase the artwork.

The status of the artwork can be divided into three categories: Not for sale / For sale soon / For sale.

2) For sale soon: When the owner registers a work for sale and the sale start date has not passed based on the current time, the status is displayed as "For sale soon" along with the price and time until the sale begins.

1_ Fixed price:
When registering sales, the owner specifies the price.



2_ Auction:
When registering sales, the owner specifies a minimum bid.




Once the sale start date has passed based on the current time, the status will change to "For sale," and buyers can purchase the work.


The status of the artwork can be divided into three categories: not for sale / for sale soon / for sale.

3) For sale: When the start date of the sale has passed based on the current time, the status will be displayed as "For Sale" with the price and end time of the sale.

1_ Fixed price:
When registering sales, the owner specifies the price.



2_ Auction: When registering sales, the owner specifies a minimum bid.




All artworks can be purchased using ACORN(point) held in my wallet. You can safely store and manage your artworks in my wallet. You can check the purchased artworks in My Gallery > My artwork.

7-2. How do I purchase artwork?

Please check if the artwork you want to purchase is in the "for sale" state first.


1) Single:

After selecting the edition of the artwork you wish to purchase, press the purchase tab to proceed with the purchase.




2) Fraction:

After selecting the piece and the number of pieces you wish to purchase, press the purchase tab to proceed with the purchase.




For physical artworks, please enter the shipping address where you will receive the actual product at the time of purchase.

You can set a default shipping address or add a new one.



If you press the shopping cart, you make a payment all at once.
In the shopping cart, you can change the selected edition for a single artwork or change the quantity for a fraction artwork.

You can check the purchased artworks in My Gallery > Owned Artworks.




8-1. How can I sell artwork?

First, before selling, the artwork you created must be approved for listing in the market by registering it as a work created in "My Gallery > Created Artworks".

Currently, two sales methods are supported: Fixed Price and Auction.


If it is the first sale registration after creating the artwork, it will be a bulk sale registration, and if you cancel the sale and register it again, it will be processed as individual sale registration.

8-2. How can I cancel the sale of artworks?

For artworks registered for sale at a fixed price, you can cancel the sale by going to "My Gallery" and selecting "Owned Artworks." For artworks registered for sale via auction, however, you cannot cancel the sale until the auction has ended, in order to ensure smooth service.




9. How do I transfer the artwork to someone else?

You can transfer the artwork if it is in the "Not for sale" state in your possession.


To transfer, select the artwork you want to transfer in your gallery and click the transfer tab.

1) Single artwork:

Select the edition of the artwork to transfer




2) Fraction artwork:
Select the fraction and the number of pieces to transfer



After checking the information of the artwork you want to transfer on the transfer page, enter the recipient's wallet address and account password.


The transfer history can be checked in the transaction history.


10. Is there a fee?

The amount that creators ultimately receive is the total commission deducted from the artwork price, which includes the sales registration fee and creator royalty.



1) Sales registration fee

All transactions, including trading artworks, are carried out through the blockchain network. The sales registration fee is a fee charged when registering an artwork for sale on the blockchain network. When the sale is completed, the fee is deducted along with the creator's royalty for settlement. The sales fee may vary up to 10%, and any changes will be announced on the service screen later.



2) Creator royalty

Creator royalty is a commission given to the creator who originally created a traded work, rather than being a service. The creator can set this commission when creating the work, and they will receive the royalty payment in proportion to the rate they have set when the work is sold. Creator royalty can be set between a minimum of 0% and a maximum of 30% when creating the work. Creator royalty can also be referred to as creator commission or secondary transaction commission.

11. What is wallet?

The wallet is an electronic wallet that securely deposits and withdraws cryptocurrency, as well as stores and transfers works.

The wallet address is a public key that allows everyone to know the user's wallet address, but knowing the user's wallet address does not give anyone the right to control their wallet.

The right to control the wallet can only be obtained if the user has a private key (master key), and it is crucial to protect the private key (master key).
